Bylaw Number 14-12

A BYLAW TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF WASTES OR REFUSE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING ANY UNPAID ACCOUNTS TO THE TAX ROLL

The Council of the Town of Canora, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1) Persons who own or occupy premises being serviced with the collection, removal or disposal of solid wastes or other refuse shall pay for such services, a service charge in accordance with those set out in Appendix "A".
- 2) Accounts for collection, removal or disposal of solid waste or other refuse, shall cover a period of three successive months, and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such periods.
- 3) Any sum payable to the urban municipality for the collection, removal or disposal of solid wastes and other refuse that remains unpaid on December 31 of the year in which the sum became payable is to be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the land and buildings in respect of which the collection, removal or disposal is done.
- 4) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of July, 2014.
- 5) Bylaw No. 10-22 is hereby repealed.

APPENDIX "A" TO BYLAW NO. 14-12**

<u>CATEGORY</u>	<u>MONTHLY CHARGE</u>
Residential	
• Any building occupied or used as a place of dwelling by not more than two families or serviced by roll out carts	\$14.00
Light commercial	
• Any premises principally used for a profession or business and shall include any building or premises not otherwise provided for in this bylaw	\$22.00
Heavy commercial	
• Any premises principally used for business engaged in any of the following:	\$50.00
1) Sale or warehousing of groceries or perishable goods	
2) Operation of a restaurant	
3) Operation of a motel or hotel with licensed premises and/or restaurant	
• Additional heavy commercial dumpsters at one location	\$20.00 each
Institutional	
• Hospitals, schools, nursing homes	\$50.00
• Additional institutional dumpsters at one location	\$20.00 each
Apartment	
• Any building occupied or used as a place of dwelling by more than two families living independently of each other	\$14.00 per unit
Churches	\$12.00
Community and church halls	\$22.00
