Bylaw Number 12-07

***A BYLAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF
GOLF CARTS IN THE TOWN OF CANORA***

The Council of the Town of Canora, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1) This bylaw may be referred to as the "Golf Cart Bylaw".
- 2) It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours of sunrise and one-half hour after sunset on all the public highways within the limits of the Town of Canora, with the exception of Main Street and Provincial Highways No. 5 and 9.
- 3) Notwithstanding Section 2 of this bylaw, it shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart on Main Street and the Provincial Highways No. 5 and 9 for purposes of crossing by the most direct route.
- 4) Persons operating a Golf Cart on the public highways within the limits of the Town of Canora must be using the golf cart for the sole purpose of transportation to and from the Golf Course, by the most direct route between the Golf Course and where the Golf Cart is stored.
- 5) Golf Carts shall carry a slow moving warning device at the rear, as near to the centre as practicable with one side parallel to and not less than 30 centimeters or more than 120 centimeters from the ground.
- 6) No person shall operate a Golf Cart on the public highways within the limits of the Town of Canora without a valid drivers' licence.
- 7) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$250.
- 8) All personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the owner/operator of the said Golf Cart.
- 9) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by the Highway Traffic Board.
