CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Property maintenance services

Town of Canora invites proposals for grounds keeping and/or property maintenance work under Nuisance Bylaw No. 05-20. The work would be under taken on private properties on behalf of the municipality.

Services are required year-round on an as-needed basis when there is non-compliance with the Nuisance Bylaw and municipal efforts to achieve compliance have failed.

There are no set hours or minimum workload. Services may be required several times a month, or may not be required at all. Deadlines are set for the commencement and completion of work. Work is carried out under the supervision of the Public Works Department and invoices are submitted to and paid by the Town.

The successful candidate must supply their own tools and/or equipment and have the ability to transport items to the landfill. Services most commonly consist of, but are not limited to: grass cutting and trimming, tree trimming, and removing refuse and/or nuisance items of various sizes from private property to the landfill.
