



Multi-Sport Court

Rules & Regulations

1. Court use is for only Pickleball, Tennis, or Basketball. No loitering.
2. No pets, skateboards, roller blades, roller skates, bicycles, etc. are permitted.
3. Users must show respect for the court and its equipment.
4. Adult supervision is strongly encouraged for all children.
5. Any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs is not permitted.
6. Profanity or obscene language is prohibited.
7. Smoking within six meters or on the sport court is prohibited.
8. Proper shoes are required at all times.
9. No food, gum, or drinks containing sugar are prohibited on the court.
Water only.
10. All litter/trash must be placed in trash container.
11. Glass is not permitted on or near the sport court.
12. Rallying against the windscreens is prohibited.
13. All players waiting to play must remain off the playing area.
14. It is the players' responsibility to ensure that the play area is free and clear of all objects on the court area.
15. Return portable pickleball nets to side after use.
16. Town owned complimentary use equipment is to remain at the court.
17. Please return equipment back to storage container and close the lid when complete.

Court Usage Guidelines

1. When court is not occupied by anyone; usage for Basketball, Tennis, or Pickleball will be available for anyone for anytime.
2. If different sport users can occupy the court at the same time without interfering with each other, then multi-sport usage is permitted.
3. If multi-sport interference occurs then the users will abide by the following **Usage Schedule**.

Weekdays (Mon - Fri) during school season (September-June)

9:00 am – 1:00 pm	Pickleball
1:00 pm – 3:30 pm	Tennis
3:30 pm – 6:00 pm	Basketball
6:00 pm – 9:00 pm	Half-court Basketball, Tennis & Pickleball

Weekends/holidays (all year) and during the summer (July - August)

9:00 am – 1:00 pm	Pickleball
1:00 pm – 4:00 pm	Basketball
4:00 pm – 7:00 pm	Tennis
7:00 pm – 9:00 pm	Half-court Basketball, Tennis & Pickleball

Any special events or tournaments must be booked through the recreational department so proper signage can be displayed at the court.
